The Organization

The Mission of Educate Magis is to create a vibrant online community to connect educators from the 2,000+ Jesuit/Ignatian schools around the world. This community, uninhibited by boundaries or borders, is opening a new way of proceeding for our schools. Educate Magis aims to enable us to collaborate in solidarity as a global community to better serve our mission – a faith that promotes justice. The <u>Educate Magis</u> community platform was launched in April 2015. Since then it has been developed further and we will continue to develop and update the platform in response to real needs of the community.

The Role

- A Global Education Director is now required to work with Educate Magis.
- You will work with, co-ordinate and manage the very committed full-time team (a
 Content Specialist, a Community Facilitator, a Digital Marketing Specialist, a Web
 Developer and a part-time Graphic Designer). You will of course be working with
 members of the world wide community and the very passionate (part-time) International
 steering group. You will report to the Community Director.
- You will be responsible for working with the community and the team to refine (and recraft as needed) the content, conversations, connections and collaboration strategy of the community. And you will be responsible to manage the ongoing execution of this strategy.
- You will work and guide our exciting new worldwide projects, i.e. Global Citizenship and Staff Formation.
- You will guide and help build our Educate Magis community through its innovative journey from early days to maturity.
- You will be communicating in both Spanish and English most days.
- You will be based with the team in an office in Galway City, Ireland.



The Opportunity

- You will be in on the ground floor of nurturing a much needed worldwide community.
 You will have the chance to make a real difference in the world of young people. You will be empowered and encouraged to achieve great results.
- You will be in community with the leaders of Jesuit Education and Ignatian Spirituality.
- You will work in an office environment where you will actively network with other content, inbound marketing and community management professionals (working on three different communities).
- You will have the opportunity for occasional travel to different parts of the world where the Jesuit Education network operates.
- We are open to candidates who wish to work for a shorter time commitment, e.g. for a two to three to four year assignment. Clearly the longer you work the more you will gain personally and professionally, but we understand that all candidates can not commit for longer periods. This is especially true for international candidates that are not sure they wish to live in Ireland for a long period. In your application please specify the time period you can commit for.

- You have experience working in an international setting and understand the importance of intercultural communication.
- You are an independent problem solver and you like to take your own initiative, but you know when to ask for help. You are very self-motivated. You are a person who can get stuff done and are prepared to work very hard. Above all you care because it matters.
